- kraft paper bags and paper bags





GLASS

- bottles and jars for drinks and food
- glass packaging for cosmetics

BIO

- vegetable and fruit waste
- branches of trees and shrubs
- mowed grass, leaves, flowers
 sawdust and tree bark
- unimpregnated woodleftovers of food
